

#### **Better Bush Tomato**

Fruit Size: 8 oz Matures: 68 days

Plant Size: 3 – 5' tall Determinate

Bears sizeable fruits on a compact plant. Works well in containers and small gardens. Especially strong, bushy plants bear truly tasty, medium-sized tomatoes great for sandwiches and slicing. The heavy foliage of this hybrid helps protect tomatoes from sunburn. Plants are strong and upright, but will still do best in a small cage or on a stake for support.



### **Centennial Tomato**

Fruit Size: 8 - 12 oz Matures: 80 days

Plant Size: 4' tall Determinate

Hybrid. An exclusive variety to mark Bonnie Plants' 100th anniversary! Produces lots of tasty, deep red slicers even in hot weather and has impressive disease resistance. Fruits are just the right size for sandwiches and burgers. Plants grow well in pots, but should be staked or caged for support.



## **Chocolate Sprinkles Tomato**

Fruit Size: 1.5" Matures: 50 days

Plant Size: 5 - 7 ' Indeterminate

Hybrid. Bite-sized, cherry-type fruits are beautifully colored — red striped with dark green — that explode with rich, robust flavor. This highly productive plant forms its fruit in clusters, and starts bearing early in the season. Support Chocolate Sprinkles Tomato with stakes or sturdy cage at planting time.



### **Golden Jubilee Tomato**

Fruit Size: 8 to 12 oz Matures: 80 days

**Indeterminate** 

Heirloom. Jubilee bears large tomatoes with very meaty, thick-walled interiors and mild flavor. The globe-shaped, golden-orange has meaty, thick walls and few seeds. High yielding. The indeterminate vines benefit from strong staking or caging.



#### **Phoenix Tomato**

Fruit size: 10 - 12 oz Matures: 70 days

Plant size: 2 -3' tall Determinate

Sets tasty fruit in summer's most intense heat. You'll see flowers and fruit on plants at the same time. If the fruit-ripening window shifts to rainy weather, Phoenix tomatoes resist cracking. Phoenix performs well as a fall crop in warmer zones.



# Pink Brandywine Tomato

Fruit size: 9 – 16 oz Matures: 90 days

Plant size: 7 - 9' tall Indeterminate

Heirloom. Beefsteak-sized, Amish tomato produces rosy pink fruits loaded with an old-fashioned tomato. The indeterminate vines are vigorous, so use tall cages. Vines yield tomatoes that ripen gradually until frost. Plants have "potato leaf" foliage.



#### **Red Pride Tomato**

Fruit size: 12 oz Matures: 78 days

Plant size: 2 -3' tall Determinate

Hybrid. Strong, vigorous plant is perfect for small gardens and containers. Good slicing tomato that resembles old-fashioned 'maters like your grandparents grew. This determinate variety needs only a short stake for support, and produces a hefty crop that ripens later in the growing season. Large leaves protect fruit from sun.



### **Red Robin Cherry Tomato**

Fruit size: 1 - 1.5" Matures: 55 days

Plant size: 8- 12" tall Determinate

Hybrid. Talk about a space-saver! This super-compact tomato plant can be as small as just 8 inches tall, making it perfect for growing in a pot on the patio. You'll be impressed by the yield from such a small plant. No need for a cage, but you may want to add a small stake for support.



#### Summer Set Tomato

Fruit size: 10 oz Plant size: 4 - 6' tall

Semi-Determinate

Hybrid tomato that sets fruit even during summer's intense heat. The large, globe-shaped tomatoes boast a firm texture and ripen relatively quickly. Fruit resists cracking even during the rainiest growing conditions. Plants are semi-determinate, plan to stake or cage them at the time of planting.



## **Super Sweet Tomato**

Fruit size: 1" Plant size: 8 - 12' tall

Indeterminate

Bears long, branched clusters of deliciously sweet tomatoes known to be disease resistant, giving plants a better chance where certain problems may be soil-borne. The indeterminate vines continue bearing until frost. Give them a tall support because they grow over the top of the cage and back down again.



# **Sweet Million Cherry Tomato**

Fruit size: ½ oz Plant size: 4-6' tall

Indeterminate

Hybrid. Plant begins bearing early and continues on through the growing season, producing many clusters of small, bright red fruit. Tomatoes are sweet-tasting, making them just the thing for snacks and salads. Crack-resistant. While vines don't tend to get as tall as many other cherry tomato varieties, plants will still need to be staked or caged.



# **Tidy Treats Tomato**

Fruit size: 1" Plant size: 3 -5' tall

**Compact Indeterminate** 

Hybrid. Prolific harvest from a sturdy, compact plant. You can expect season-long growth that starts early and keeps producing fruit all summer long. Bite-sized cherry tomatoes form in grape-like clusters and ripen to a bright red. Not a tall-growing plant, but it appreciates the support of a stake or cage.
